The product is easy to use. Once placed in the condensate collection tank, it is immediately active and its action remains for the entire season.

Available in sets of 6 pads to be used in a single solution.

Specific product for medium-large air conditioning systems (fancoil, AHU).

Compatible with all materials present in air conditioning systems, including light alloys.

SPECIFICATIONS

Contains sanitizers, corrosion inhibitors, detergents for the complete treatment of the system.

The two-segment blister ensures the immediate release of the active ingredients (smaller segment) which become available immediately after the introduction of the product. The blister also ensures a constant long-lasting dosage (larger segment equipped with a sponge).

The new waxy form ensures an even more gradual release of the active ingredients over time, in particular prolonging the sanitising activity for the entire season.

Tested according to UNI EN 1040:2005

USE

Remove the tablet from the plastic bag.

Place the blister on a flat surface and, using your thumb, firmly press the smallest portion of the blister in order to activate the product.

Place the blister in the collection tank with the side of the sponge facing downwards so that the condensation water can

wet the bar and progressively solubilise the active ingredient. A single blister can treat a single fancoil for an entire operating season (5-6 months).

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE
